I also spent many years as core staff for the Wise Woman Tradition, cooperatively running one of the largest women's conferences in the US. And, I am a level one certified ParaYoga teacher, who has been skirting around the edges of the community since 2004.

When a caterpillar goes into a chrysalis its "caterpillar" cells dissolve before the "butterfly" cells emerge. Scientists call these in-between cells IMAGINAL cells. It is a place ripe with potential—and it feels similar to where we are as a community in this significant moment in time.
